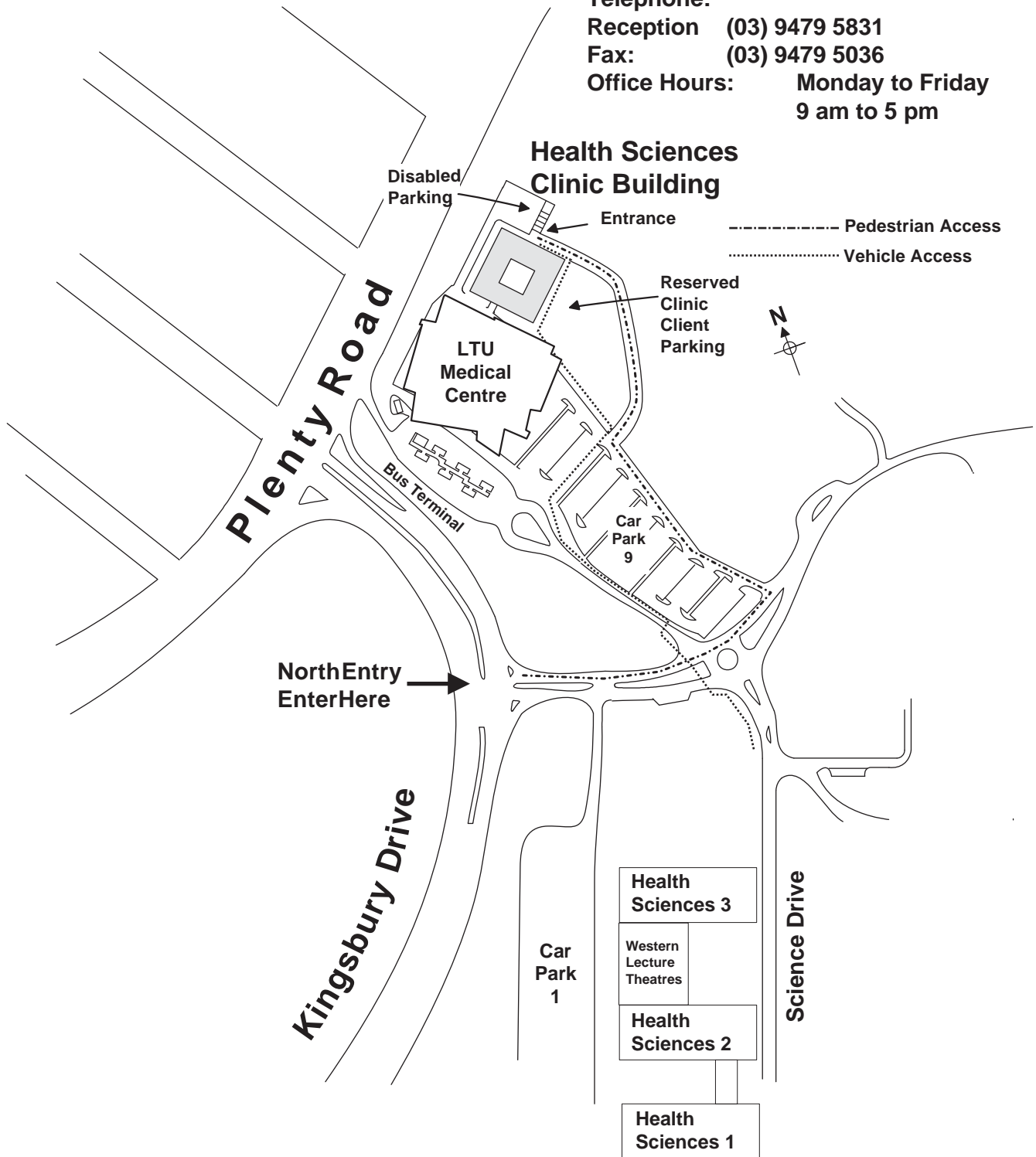


# Health Sciences Clinic Building

## Map and Directions:

If you are travelling in from the north, perhaps coming from the Metropolitan Ring Road or the northern suburbs, you need to travel south along Plenty Road until you approach the intersection of Plenty Road and Kingsbury Drive, Bundoora.

On your left, you will see the Health Sciences Clinic building just before the La Trobe University Medical Centre and the university bus terminus. Even though you can see the Health Sciences Clinic building, you can't enter its car park from Plenty Road. Please follow the directions below.

Turn left into Kingsbury Drive and drive approximately 150 metres until you approach the Kingsbury Drive/Ring Road traffic lights.

Turn LEFT at the lights onto the university Ring Road and proceed down through and past a large round-about . In approximately 40 metres turn LEFT into the road that leads towards the La Trobe University Medical Centre. Continue on until you see the sign indicating a RIGHT turn towards the Health Sciences Clinic building, Prosthetics & Orthotics and Podiatry.

You can park in any of the marked spaces in the larger bottom car park, including the \*green lined Health Science Clinic permit only spaces, or you can continue on towards the Health Science Clinic Main Entrance and the smaller upper car park and park in one of the \*green lined or blue lined Disabled Permit spaces (if you have the appropriate permit for your car).

\*Make sure you ask for a day parking permit from myself or from the Reception staff when you arrive.

If you are travelling north along Plenty Road from Preston, turn RIGHT at the Kingsbury Drive intersection and proceed as per the above directions.

If you are coming from the Heidelberg area along Kingsbury Drive, turn RIGHT at the Kingsbury Drive/Ring Road traffic lights and proceed as per above directions.
